On the cover: The Charles S. Chapman NA map of Leonia, an artistic representation based on the Hughes Map printed in 1867, was created for the Borough's 1944 *Leonia Semi-Centennial* journal. The original is owned by the Leonia Board of Education Art Collection. Numbers and letters superimposed on this map indicate the present-day location of most of Leonia's historical markers, which are labeled and explained below.

BRONZE HISTORICAL SIGNAGE

Much of Leonia's historical signage refers to the American Revolution, a testament to the role of our area in the establishment of US independence. A series of bronze markers was installed by the Borough in 1968 when it celebrated Leonia's 300th anniversary – a number based on the local phrase "Leonia settled 1668," which is the date of the earliest known deed for land that is today within the municipality.



On the front cover **1** is located across from the Public Library and marks the 1780 encampment of the Continental Army under the Marquis de Lafayette. **2** is a bronze bas-relief on the front yard of the Leonia Presbyterian Church that portrays Gen. George Washington's Army's Retreat down Fort Lee Road on Nov. 20, 1776. See the photo below of the sculpture's public dedication on July 4, 1916.

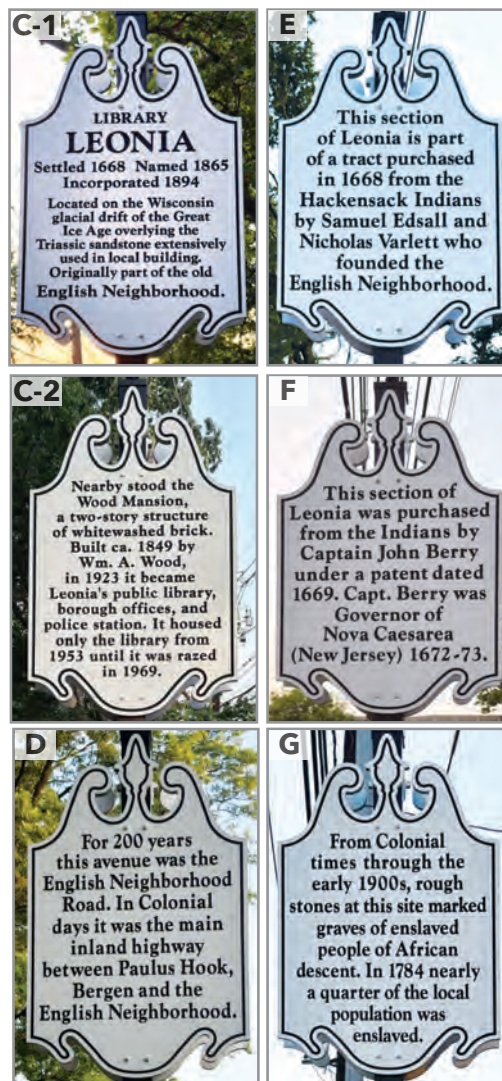
3 is the vicinity of Day's Tavern, believed to have been Gen. Nathaniel Greene's headquarters in summer and fall of 1776.

4 is Leonia's oldest dwelling and only pre-Revolutionary structure at 112 Prospect Street. It is on the NJ and National Registers of Historic Places. It has been owned by the Boyd Family since 1916 when they added onto it an art studio whose construction is consistent with the house's earlier two sections. Current Mayor Bill Ziegler inhabits this home with his wife Sue Boyd.

5 The Civil War Drill Hall Theater, originally built in 1859 as an armory and mustering site, is listed on the NJ & National Registers of Historic Places. It was repurposed in 1993 to be the home of the Players Guild of Leonia, which was founded in 1919 and is New Jersey's longest-running community theater. It has official historic designation by the Borough of Leonia.

"DR. HIXSON SIGNS" ACROSS LEONIA

Renewed in 2020 by the Borough these six two-sided historical markers at the town's gateways and center have likely been displayed since 1926. They were the brainchild of Prof. Arthur W. Hixson, Columbia University chemist and Leonia resident who chaired the town's first Planning Board. Their design was by prolific multimedia artist John Rutherford Boyd of the "Boyd House" (see **4**). Their text comes mostly from a paper on Leonia's history by school teacher and town resident Robert Hill Greene, delivered for and published by the Bergen County Historical Society in 1920.



A This sign on east Fort Lee Road just below the Fort Lee border is duplicated to the west at Grand Ave. and throughout Bergen County to indicate the path of Washington's Retreat.

B Historical reenactments of the Retreat have taken place over the years along this route.

C-1 & C-2 The current Leonia Public Library was constructed in 1969.

D Before residents created and publicly adopted the name *Leonia* on Nov. 13, 1865, the unincorporated hamlet had been part of the *English Neighborhood* that stretched along Grand Ave. (formerly: the English Neighborhood Road) from today's Fairview through downtown Englewood.

E The 1668 deed to this part of town is what has inspired the language on all the gateway "Dr. Hixson signs" and on the

6 Site of the original Dutch Reformed Church of the English Neighborhood (1768-1792) per the area's oldest known map drawn in 1778 by Robert Erskine, George Washington's mapmaker. The church was used as a hospital and guardhouse during the Revolutionary War; it was reconstructed in Ridgefield in 1793 where it still stands.

7 The magnificent Vreeland House at 125 Lakeview Avenue is heralded by a bronze marker as well as this Bergen County Historical Society "blue marker" and a National Register of Historic Places plaque; the property is also on the NJ Register.

8 Nearby was a grist mill documented on the 1778 Erskine Map and in Thomas Paine's 1776 *The American Crisis*, famous for its line: "These are the times that try men's souls."

9 Route 93, named Grand Avenue since 1870, had been the English Neighborhood Road.

"WASHINGTON'S RETREAT" BY MAHONRI YOUNG

This photo (left) is of the dedication on July 4, 1916, of the bronze sculpture by multimedia artist Mahonri Young (grandson of Brigham Young), a resident of Leonia and member of its "art colony." The work commemorates Gen. Washington's Retreat down Fort Lee Road, overlooking the Retreat Route from atop the Leonia Presbyterian Church front yard. It was commissioned by the Men's Neighborhood Club that met at the church and gifted it to the Borough.

BE FLOOD RESILIENT!

Climate change is upon us. As any hydraulic engineer will tell you, we can now expect the rains to be intense, followed by long periods of dryness. The Department of Public Works clears out catch basins and stormwater drains on a disciplined periodic schedule with additional maintenance before an expected heavy storm to ensure unobstructed flows of stormwater.

But this is only a part of it – property owners should do what they can to protect themselves. As per our insurance carrier, one often easy way to protect your property is to make sure that the landscape grade, including downspouts, walkways and driveways, directs water away from your building rather than allowing water to enter.

TURNING FOOD WASTE INTO BIOMASS

In honor of Earth Day on April 22, the ACS Elementary School Student Council, in collaboration with the Leonia Environmental Commission and district Green Team, distributed tree saplings and biomass created from the school's food waste converter.

The food waste converter turns the cafeteria waste into soil overnight, which helps reduce daily food waste from 11 bags of daily food waste to 2. The Buildings and Grounds department then utilizes the biomass to fertilize the grass, trees, and flowers around our schools.

SPECIAL SERVICES

Leonia Public Schools is committed to providing individualized support for students with diverse learning needs. Through our Special Services Department, led by our Director of Special Services, we offer a range of programs and services for students who qualify for special education, including individualized education programs (IEPs), related services, and specialized instruction. Education and related services are provided by professional staff members: teachers, school psychologists, school social workers, learning consultants, speech language pathologists, occupational and physical therapists. Our team works closely with families, teachers, and support staff to ensure that every student receives the appropriate services in the least restrictive environment. We strive to foster academic, social, and emotional growth while promoting inclusion, equity, and student success. Visit our district website to learn more about our programs, procedures, and offerings.

ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

Leonia Public Schools is committed to meeting the needs of all learners through both academic support and enrichment. For students who demonstrate mastery of core content and would benefit from advanced learning experiences, the district offers a Gifted & Talented program aligned with New Jersey's educational standards. Students are identified for the program through multiple measures and criteria, ensuring an equitable and comprehensive selection process. Our programs provide enriched instruction through in-class differentiation, small group learning, and project-based experiences. These supports are aligned with best practices under the New Jersey Tiered System of Supports (NJTSS). Students in grades 6-8 are identified and enrolled in portfolio classes in Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies. At the high school, students may enroll in Advanced Placement and Honors courses in a number of subjects. High school students can also participate in Dual Enrollment classes to receive college credits, while completing their high school requirements. For more information, visit our district website.

MULTILINGUAL LEARNERS

Leonia celebrates its rich linguistic diversity, with more than 40 languages spoken in our homes. Our Multilingual Learner program honors students' heritage languages while supporting them in developing strong English skills. Available at every grade level, our courses focus on oral communication, reading, and writing to empower learners academically and socially.

HIGH SCHOOL ACADEMY PROGRAM

Leonia High School offers seven specialized academies that provide students with opportunities to explore their interests and prepare for future careers. These include the Leonia Academy of STEM (LAS), which features six areas of concentration; the Leonia Academy for Hospitality and Culinary Arts (LAHCA); the Marketing and Business Leadership Academy (MBLA), offering majors in Economics and Marketing; the Leonia Humanities Academy (LHA), which includes the School of Literature and Language and the School of Social Sciences; the Leonia Music Conservatory (LMAC – Music); the Leonia Fine Arts Conservatory (LMAC – Fine Arts); and the Academy for Vocational and Trade (AVT). For more information, visit our school's website.

STUDENT SERVICES

The Student Services department, led by our Director of Student Services, supports the academic, social, and emotional development of all students. The department consists of one counselor at ACS, three at LMS, and four counselors at LHS. Counselors work closely with students, families, and staff to promote well-being, support mental health, and guide students through each stage of their educational journey. At ACS, the school counselor provides advice, support, and help in educational and personal development for the students at ACS. The school counselor is also available as a resource to parents who may have questions or concerns about their child. At the middle school, counselors provide counseling services, both individual and group, monitor student achievement, and maintain open lines of communication between parents and staff. At the high school, the school counselors provide career and college counseling, as well as support services for youths at risk.

I&RS COMMITTEE

Each school's Intervention & Referral Services (I&RS) Committee is made up of school administrators, teachers, counselors, child study team members, and parents. The I&RS committee meets to discuss strategies and resources for faculty and parents to employ within the general education curriculum to better support the individual student's needs.

FOOD SERVICES

All three schools have a cafeteria and provide low cost, nutritionally balanced hot and cold breakfast and lunch service daily. Free or reduced price breakfast and lunch are available to students who qualify under state and federal programs.

HEALTH SERVICES

School nurses in each school conduct screenings for vision, hearing and scoliosis (curvature of the spine); maintain health records; record height and weight and blood pressure; administer medications (if a note from the doctor has been provided); and provide emergency care. The school nurse may also make referrals regarding possible emotional or physical difficulties. If a child becomes ill during school, he/she will be sent to the nurse's office. If, in the opinion of the school nurse, the child is unable to remain in school, a parent will be contacted and asked to pick up his/her child to take him/her home. A complete physical is required for children in kindergarten, fourth, seventh and tenth grades.

AFTER SCHOOL CHILD CARE

Leonia School Age Child Care (SACC), an organization run by an independent board, provides child care services for students in grades Pre-K to 6 at Anna C. Scott School. Students can be dropped off as early as 7:00am and picked up no later than 6:00pm. SACC can be reached at (201) 944-6715.

AFTER SCHOOL ENRICHMENT

Our district offers after school enrichment classes for ACS students in grades 1 to 4. A variety of courses are offered for a fee. Please keep an eye out for more information from ACS school.

Home Improvement Permits: If you plan to improve the inside or outside of your property, you must have a permit! Examples of when permits are required include new additions, decks, finishing a basement, remodeling, installation of central air conditioning, replacement of a hot water heater, installing or replacing a fence, and switching from gas to oil heating or vice versa. Please contact the Building Department if you have any questions regarding Permit requirements. **(201) 592-5780 ext. 253.**

Property Maintenance: The owner of the home is responsible for general property maintenance. This includes painting of structures, maintaining leaders, sidewalks, gutters and roofs, and overall appearance of property. Grass must be cut when 4" or higher. All shrubs and bushes must be cut back and trimmed away from all walkways and driveways/roadways so as not to inhibit pedestrian's and vehicle's view. Garbage cans should not be visible from the street. The Property Maintenance Inspector will impose fines if property and businesses are not properly maintained. Permits for Tree Removal: If your tree is more than 8" in diameter at breast height, you must apply for a tree removal permit from the Building Department. There is a permit fee, a tree replacement fee and a tree inspection fee (as necessary). Residents are not permitted to remove Borough trees. Please contact the Building Department if you have any questions regarding Permit requirements. **(201) 592-5780 ext. 253.**

Illegal Conversion of Dwellings: Conversion of apartments and single-family dwellings into two and three-family units is illegal and will not be tolerated in Leonia. If you believe an illegal dwelling unit exists, contact the Building Department and your complaint will be investigated. **(201) 592-5780 ext. 253.**

SANITATION SERVICES

The DPW picks up garbage, trash, recyclables, yard waste, and white goods. All trash and collectables must be at the curb by 7:00 am but not before 5:00 pm on the preceding day. Residents should not drop off any refuse or anything else at the DPW, as it is closed for public access. Sign up for the app Recycle Coach which provides up to date information on schedule and FAQs.

Garbage (household refuse) is collected Tuesdays and Fridays curbside. It must be in sealed plastic bags, not loose in a can. Trash cans should not exceed 32 gallons in size and, when full, 50 lbs in weight. Do not put uncontained bags at curb.

Trash bulky items (such as furniture, rugs, mattresses and box springs) are picked up curbside on alternate Mondays (north of Fort Lee Road) and Thursdays (south of Fort Lee Road). Tires, large appliances, and yard waste are not considered trash.

Recyclable materials (paper, glass, bottles, cans) are picked up every Wednesday at the curb. Mixed paper alternates with commingled (cans, bottles, hard plastics ♻️♻️♻️) recyclables. All mixed recyclables should be rinsed. Do not bring directly to DPW. Materials should be in rigid containers, **NO PLASTIC BAGS!**

Styrofoam may NOT be put out with garbage or bulk trash collection. Leonia Residents must drop off clean and dry polystyrene (styrofoam) at the DPW. Look for the yellow dumpster. Don't get a violation - recycle properly. For more information, visit leonianj.gov or Recycle Coach.

Yard Waste (branches, leaves, grass clippings) is picked up at the curb on alternate Mondays. Loose clippings should be in rigid containers or biodegradable bags that do not exceed 50 pounds. Branches, limbs and shrubbery should be bundled. **NO PLASTIC BAGS!** Landscapers are responsible for removing the yard waste they create.

Loose Leaves can be raked into piles at the curb from October through December only and must be 20 ft. from catch basins. Branches, brush and grass clippings should not be mixed with the leaves. **Plastic bags with leaves will NOT be picked up!**

White goods (large metal appliances such as refrigerators, washing machines and air conditioners) can be scheduled for pickup by calling **(201) 592-5790**. Do not place items out before calling DPW.

Hazardous Waste is not collected by the Leonia DPW. You can dispose of your hazardous waste in Mahwah, Bergen Community College, and Moonachie. For dates call 201-807-5825 or visit www.njihazwaste.com or www.bcua.org

BOROUGH ORDINANCES

A number of Borough ordinances are enforced to ensure a pleasant quality of life for all. A complete list of ordinances can be found on the Borough website www.leonianj.gov

Street Parking: Parking on Borough streets from 9:00am to 11:00am is restricted except for vehicles displaying resident, guest or employee hang tags. Check leonianj.gov on ways to obtain a permit.

Business District Parking: Limited to two hours. No parking along Broad Avenue from 11:00pm to 6:00am to facilitate street cleaning. No U-turns.

Elm Place / Beechwood Parking Lot: Permits available at Borough Hall - \$200 annual fee. Commercial Vehicles - \$1,200.

Speed Limit: The speed limit is 25 mph on all Borough streets, unless otherwise posted.

Noise: Commercial landscaping equipment—Mon-Fri 8:00am to 6:00pm. Sat 9:00am to 2:00pm. Sun prohibited. Gas-powered leaf blowers may be used Oct 15 to Dec 15 and Mar 15 to May 15 only.

Safety: Children 14 and under must wear helmets when riding bicycles, skateboards or scooters.

Off-Leash Dogs: Dudley C. Allen Park (Lakeview Park) shall be available for off-leash pet hours at all times the park is open to the public, which is from dawn to dusk.

Snow Removal: Snow and ice must be removed from sidewalks within 24-48 hours after cessation of the storm. Please park cars in driveways during snowstorms to facilitate snow removal on the streets.

Borough Trees: The Shade Tree Commission plants trees on the Borough right of way in front of homes. If you would like a tree planted in front of your home, or need your Borough tree trimmed or pruned, go to leonianj.gov and "submit a tree issue." You may not cut down or alter a borough tree.

ENTITLEMENT TO ATTEND THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS ON A TUITION-FREE BASIS

State law (N.J.S.A. 18A: 38-1) stipulates that the children of legal residents of Leonia are entitled to attend the Leonia Public Schools on a tuition free basis. (Leonia's sending/receiving relationship with Edgewater entitles Edgewater students to attend the Leonia Public Schools in grades 7-12.)

As stated in Board Policies (Nos. 5111 & 5118), "The mere owning of any property whatsoever does not qualify a parent/guardian to send children to school in this school district." Additionally, "The Board reserves the right to verify the residency of any pupil and the validity of any affidavit of guardianship." Upon registering a student, parents/guardians must present appropriate documentation demonstrating residency. Affidavit submissions must also comply with applicable state law.

The Leonia Public Schools accepts tuition students on a limited basis and under certain conditions.

Students who are found to be in attendance in the Leonia Public Schools without any entitlement to do so on a tuition-free basis will be removed from school. Their parents/guardians will be subject to the payment of tuition calculated on a per diem basis for the length of enrollment.

PHYSICAL EXAMS

Physical examinations are required by the Board of Education before kindergarten, 4th, 7th, and 10th grades. Students participating in sports need an annual physical along with state-mandated age-appropriate vaccinations.
